Works of Mercy Projects/Activities Guidelines

- ✓ Fifteen (15) Work of Mercy Hours are required to be completed during each year Confirmation Preparation.
- ✓ A minimum of five (5) hours is required for each category of Works of Mercy, Corporal and Spiritual, each year.
- ✓ A maximum of five (5) hours is earned for any given activity, unless otherwise indicated on the *Examples of Confirmation Works of Mercy Projects* document.
- ✓ Please remember to obtain Leader signature at the time the Work of Mercy is completed. Remember to bring the form with you!
- ✓ Completed Work of Mercy Activity Forms must be submitted by no later than March 29 (Sunday class) or March 31 (Tuesday class), 2020.
- ✓ **Grade/Level 7 Students: Promotion to the second year of Confirmation Preparation is contingent upon completion of the Grade 7 Works of Mercy requirement.**
